

How It Works

Step 1: Contact the SMART program via Neva Stotler.

Step 2: Review your issues, e.g., we need to replace our manager, who has notified us that she intends to retire at the end of the year, or without notice our director of public works has resigned.

Step 3: Through assessment tools, meetings, and conversations, a plan will be formalized for, as in the examples above, the immediate and long-term succession, including costs associated with the process. Geography, the size of the municipality, and staffing will all play a part in how the issues are addressed. In replacing a manager, elevating from within the organization, assessment of needs pending a permanent replacement, and a replacement search may be parts of the SMART plan.

Step 4: The plan is implemented through one or more professionals across the Commonwealth who meet the client's needs, and the SMART facilitator will track the progress and goals.
